## **Tuition Fees & Payments**

\*Tuition fees are paid monthly. Rates are for the full season, Sept-June (June prorated 1/2) including studio holidays, inclement weather days, and intersession breaks. They are averaged in monthly amounts, not by the number of classes in each month so they are consistent. A full season of dance is a minimum of 32

\*After registering, monthly tuition will be paid by automatic debit or credit card payment on the 6th of each remaining month. There will be a 3.5% convenience fee on credit and debit card payments. To avoid this fee, please pay by cash or check before the 5th of the month (regardless of when classes begin that month). After the 5th, all cards on file will automatically be charged.

\*There is a \$25 fee on NSF accounts and a 5% fee will be assessed on late accounts (after the 6th of the month).

#### **Discounts**

\*Siblings receive a 10% discount on the smaller tuition account for regular school year classes. No sibling discount on private lessons, solo/duo/trio choreography, master classes, or camps.

\*Individual students who take multiple classes receive a discount on additional classes. See the tuition chart on our schedule.

#### Withdrawal from Class

The front desk must be notified if a dancer needs to withdraw by the 25th of the month to discontinue any tuition charges. After the 25th of the month, tuition will be posted for the new month and will be due in full.

#### Missed Classes and Refunds

\*Refunds are only issued if TDH needs to cancel a class due to low enrollment.

\*There are no refunds or pro-rated fees for missed classes or withdrawals. This includes any prepaid classes. Students may make up any missed classes in another same or lower level class in a discipline approved by the instructor.

#### Attire/Dress Code

Proper attire and hair etiquette are required for all classes. Dress code/hair requirements are published on our website. All required items will be available for purchase online (details on website). Sizing can be done at the studio during Open House and later at the desk. Studio logo wear will also be made available for purchase at Open House and in special orders during the season.

#### **Inclement Weather Policy**

\*In the event of inclement weather, a text & email will be sent and a post will be made on Social Media by 3:00p.m. We will also announce the closing on newsnet5.com

\*Please note that we do not necessarily follow school closings as our students attend multiple districts and roads often clear by the time studio classes begin. Similarly, the weather sometimes turns poor as the day progresses.

\*Calamity days may be made up at the family's discretion from our regular schedule of classes (see Missed Classes).

### **Recital Costume Orders**

\*All classes have a costume unless communicated by the instructor and the studio.

Costume fees (due no later than December 14th): \$89-99/class

\*\*Please notify the desk by December 1st if your dancer will not be participating in the recital

\*Recital costumes must be paid by December 14th and are not refundable. Costumes will be ordered over the holiday break and will not be ordered unless paid in full (no exceptions).

\*Students are measured for costumes in classes and they will be delivered in March-May. If a costume does not fit, exchanges can be made within a week of receiving without a cost to you, as long as there are no availability issues. After that week, additional shipping/handling fees may be charged.

#### Annual Recital

\*TDH's recital each June is a great way for our performers to showcase their talents, hard work, and progress! TDH's recital offers our students a professionally directed performance at the Medina Performing Arts Center (Medina High School). Participation is encouraged, but not required.

\*Specific show assignments will be published as soon as possible. Recital details will be published on our website. Each class is in one of our two shows. If your child is in more than one class, they could dance in more than one show. Specific rehearsal assignments will be published in May this year.
